U.S. News & World Report Recognizes 5 Springpoint Communities as Best Nursing Homes for Short-Term Rehabilitation for 2023-2024



Wall Township, New Jersey–November 21, 2023–Five Springpoint communities have been recognized as Best Nursing Homes for short-term rehabilitation for 2023-2024 by <u>U.S. News & World Report</u>. This report evaluated more than 15,000 nursing homes on resident care and safety, infection rates, staffing, health inspection results, and other indicators of quality, with only 19% of skilled nursing facilities nationwide earned the "Best Nursing Home" designation.

There are currently 348 nursing homes throughout the state of New Jersey, and these Springpoint communities are among a distinguished group to receive such a high overall rating. They each received a High-Performance rating in short-term rehabilitation, which is based on U.S. News' assessment of ten quality measures focused on staffing, medical outcomes, resident complaints, and processes of care.
